If a company is the owner of the mobile number/subscription with the current operator, it is the responsible's name in block letters that must be written, as well as his/her signature and a possibly a company stamp.

Please note that you are responsible for any ongoing termination, porting or reorganization of telephone number/numbers with your current provider, that may have impact on or conflicts with the porting of your telephone number/numbers.

## General rules for number porting.

Number porting to Dstny a/s typically takes 4-5 days from other providers.

This time is calculated from Dstny A / S receives the signed power of attorney and this is approved, until the number has been moved.

In some cases, however, it is necessary to terminate or change various additional services with the existing operator, before it is possible to port a given number or numbers. The time taken for this must be added to the above estimate.

Listed below are typical services to be aware of at the existing telecommunications company prior to one-port porting:

- Alarm: Must be transferred to an independent subscription or terminated before the number can be moved.
- ADSL & SHDSL: Must be moved to second line or created on new line.
- If it is a subnumber that needs to be moved, while the main number is to remain, it is only possible if it is first changed to an independent subscription.

You should be aware that you may be charged additional costs by your current operator in connection with the above.
